PROGRAM INFORMATION

**CAMPOREE PROGRAM WILL BE OPEN TO ALL CUB SCOUTS THIS YEAR!!**

Camp sign up will be limited to the first 600 scouts and scouters who pre-register. This is to accommodate capacity restrictions for Camp Oest. Units must pre-register with roster of youth/adult names. Rosters will be available at March & April RT. A scanned copy of the Roster will be available online but must be presented in triplicate. Friday night walk in registration will be dependant on total number of participants. The Harford District Activities Committee will close registrations when total participant headcount reaches 600 and no walk in registrations will be permitted. Campsites will be assigned to units by the Harford District Activities Committee and will be dependant on roster/registration head count per unit. Campsite assignments will be emailed to unit leaders the last week of April.

The program is open to all Cub Scouts, **Tigers through Webelos**, with parent participation only. One Scout-One Adult Scouter requirement is required for all Cub Scouts.

The Dens will follow a trail that will include scout skill style competition. The station competition will be done on a Den basis and awards will be determined by top ten Den scores.

ADMINISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration - \$7.00 per individual. This covers a patch, Broad Creek camping fee, liability insurance and program materials.

**REMEMBER!** Camporee registrations will be limited to the first 600 scouts and scouters. Pre-registration will take place at the roundtables in March and April. At that time we will need unit number, contact information, the number of Dens (differentiated by group: # tigers, # bears, # Jr. Webelos). Campsites will be assigned to units by the Harford District Activities Committee and will be dependant on roster/registration head count per unit. Campsite assignments will be emailed to unit leaders the last week of April. Final payment is due May 02, 2008 upon arrival and registration at camp.

**PARKING CONSIDERATIONS** – To conserve parking space at Camp Oest, we are asking that each unit carpool as much as possible, and if possible refrain from bringing trailers. For those units that do bring trailers, we may require that once all of the necessary equipment for the weekend is removed that it be moved over to the back of the Camp Saffran parking lot so that we have space available for cars. Finally, please implement stadium style parking so that we can get everyone into the parking lot. With your cooperation, we should limit the parking problems and make the registration process smooth for all.
