We are in need of many Boy Scouts this summer. We are estimating we will need about 75+ boys per day. Here are some of my thoughts:

- We will be running many stations where the boys can hone their leadership skills – think Camporee style
- Our intent is to have many stations manned and led by boy scouts
- We will also need station help for BB, Archery (must be at least 1st class for shooting sports), fishing, woodworking, craft, sports programs and more
- Will have a mandatory Orientation and training to ensure you understand what we expect from you.
- Orientation is mandatory....there are 1000 people a day at camp....we must review safety information. We will go over the program, answer any questions and hand out the program guides.
- Orientation dates are May 27th OR 29th at Patterson Mill Middle/High School cafeteria. Only attend one.
- Lower rank boys can practice some of their required skills like first aid
- Service hours available for both Scouting and Harford County Board of Ed
- Class B uniform to promote Troop
- Register on-line – more info to follow on that
- No charge. More days they give....more stuff they will walk away with (shirts, hats, misc)

There are many youth signing up to help at camp. Boy Scouts come 1st. Higher ranking boy will have priority.

I have many boys that have just crossed over signing up on-line. There is a possibility I may need to limit the number of those boys in some way, but please signup if you want to help.

Remember, this is not camp for you. This is a job. You are expected to show off your skills and get the cubs excited about becoming boy scouts.
