The Camp Gadget

Your group will need to can work together as a team to make a useful Camp Gadget for your campsite. The Scout Patrol's can help the Webelos Den's with this Event.

Examples of Camp Gadgets are towel rack, flag pole, fire pail rack, equipment stand. A good resource is your scout handbook, the Field Book and on-line websites.

This can be completed prior to the weekend of the Fall Camporee. It will also be an activity that your den or patrol can build that weekend.

THE REQUIREMENTS

1 – You may use wood, rope, twine and other natural materials to build the project. See the Pioneering Merit Badge book for examples of other acceptable materials.

Please, for everyone's safety, do not use nails, screws or other materials that would not be normally used for a scout camp gadget.

#2 – Utilize the information that will be available at the station that weekend or research the many websites that contain information on Scout Camp Gadgets. The most helpful site that I produced copies of sample projects from was: Rosegarden's BSA Scouting Resources.
