As program chair for this years' Operation Icicle I am requesting patch design ideas from the scouts of Harford District Troops. Below are the requirements that must be utilized in order for your patch design to be considered and then be part of the SPL vote at the November Roundtable.

**PATCH – MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING**

- \* Design must be on a clean white sheet of paper
- \* The dimension must be a 3” round patch
- \* Must include the wording – ‘Harford District 2009 Operation Icicle’
- \* Must include the wording – ‘Broad Creek Memorial Hospital’
- \* Specify the 3 colors used or have the design produced in color
- \* Include on the back of the sheet: the scouts name, troop number
- \* Must include the scout **"Fleur-de-Lis"** symbol

Scouts will visit various departments (stations):

Scout skills for each station will include First Aid, Pioneering, Camping, Orienteering, Nature, Communication, and my favorite: Knots.

**ADMINISTRATION INFORMATION**

Please note that the patch design must be done by a Boy Scout, not an adult leader.

Any design, determined to be in bad taste or does not conform to the Scout Law ‘a scout is clean’, will be removed from the voting by the Program Chair.

The patch may be submitted by a troop leader at the November Roundtable and must be present by 7:30PM.

Only the SPL or his representative may vote at the meeting. No adult leader will be allowed to participate in the voting.
