- _____ sleeping bag or blanket(s) and a blanket and foam pad to put on the bed springs
- _____ pillow and pillowcase, and a sheet for hot nights
- _____ jacket, sweater or sweatshirt, and sweatpants
- _____ extra shorts and T-shirts, plus long pants
- _____ 6 sets of extra underwear
- _____ 6 pair of extra socks (at least one extra scout crew socks)
- _____ bathing suit and beach towel, plus light cover clothing to keep the sun off
- _____ extra pair of shoes or boots (one pair of hiking boots is a must), plus flip-flops or old sneakers
- _____ pajamas or other sleeping clothes
- _____ rain gear
- _____ flashlight & extra batteries
- _____ insect repellent
- _____ pocket knife & Totin' Chip Card
- _____ compass
- _____ camera and film (optional)
- _____ Boy Scout Handbook, notebook, paper, pen or pencil
- _____ merit badge equipment and prerequisites (if taking swimming merit badge - long sleeve button front shirt, long pants, belt, and old sneakers that can all get wet)
- _____ towel & washcloth, toothbrush & toothpaste, soap & toilet paper
- _____ day pack, plus backpack if going for camping or wilderness survival merit badge
- _____ mess kit (or plate & cup), vittle kit (knife, fork, and spoon), and canteen
- _____ first aid kit
- _____ lockable suitcase, plastic storage box, or footlocker and padlock
